We amplify the voices of women in maritime trades and showcase maritime cultural heritage.



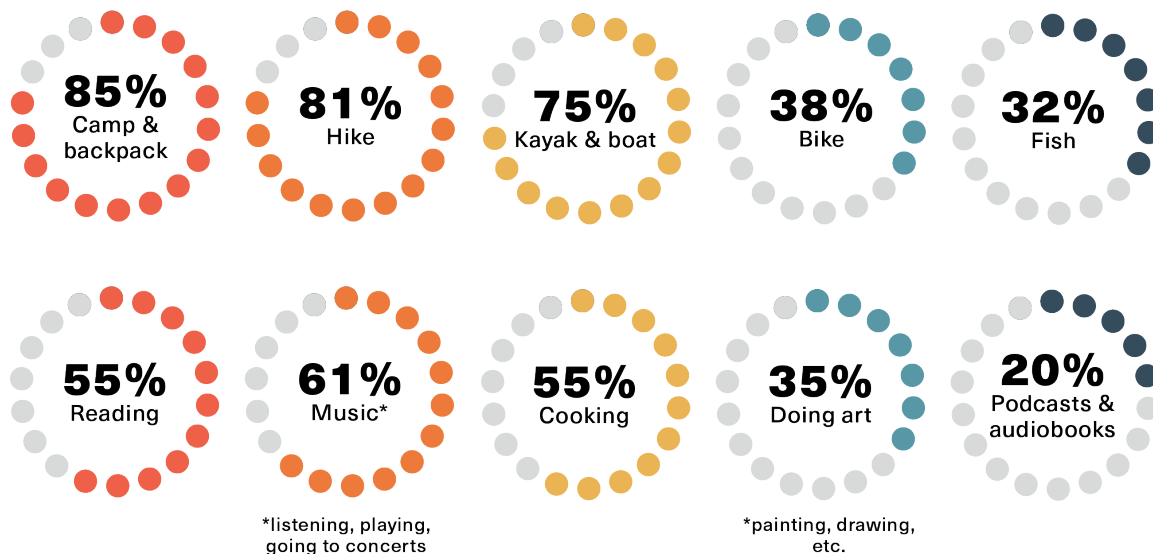
Conservation

From hands-on activities to interactive lessons, we inspire the next generation to understand and protect our shared marine environment.

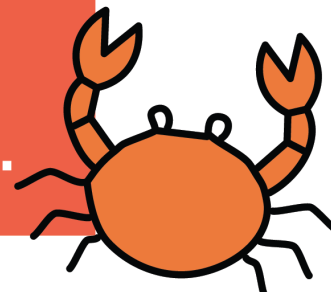
